You will be aware by now that Public Consultation has begun on the planning for the new St Cyres School.

Two public meetings were held on the school site last week during which local residents expressed some concerns about perceived traffic issues on Sully Road and St Cyres Road surrounding the plans for both St Cyres and the new special school.

I am writing to enlist your help in ensuring that the consultation reflects a balanced view.

We have waited many years for the go ahead to start the building of the desperately needed new St Cyres School and it would be a shame if the silent majority of parents were unable to express their views on the absolute necessity for these plans to go ahead. Failure to do so now could mean the withdrawal of funding by the Welsh Government or the Local Authority, as there are many other sectors clamouring for public funding at present.
