

Using Google Classroom on a PC, Mac or Laptop

You can access your Google Classroom on any computer by using your school email address and password. This is useful if you have to do a task which requires extended typing which can be difficult on an iPad. By logging on to Google Classroom on a computer, this will also give you access to the other 'Google Apps for Education' such as Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, as well as Google Drive.

This approach applies to all computers wherever you are. Therefore, you could do this whether you are in school (eg in the LRC or in the 6th Form Centre) or at home, or indeed, anywhere else!

Stage 1

Load your web browser (eg Internet Explorer, Safari, Google Chrome, etc) and enter the following URL:

<https://classroom.google.com/>

Alternatively, just search for Google Classroom and it is usually the top link.

Stage 2

Click on the 'Sign In' button on the Home Page for Google Classroom and then type in your school email address and then click on 'Next' to type in your password.

If this is your own computer or a computer at home, you can tick the 'keep me logged in'. However, if other people in your family use the same computer, they might have access to your work which is not advisable.

Now that you have logged into Google Classroom, you have exactly the same functionality as you have on the iPad App.
