Although the list of key workers has yet to be finalised by Welsh Government, I have included a working definition below.

This facility should be used only by families who need it. If you are a key worker, but your partner is not, we ask you to organise other arrangements. If you are able to put in place other suitable arrangements at any point we would be extremely grateful. As a school we are here to support and help you in any way we can. In order to help us make fit and proper arrangements, would you please email the school informing us if you would need to use this service.

Key Workers are defined as: -

Key workers as those 'blue light' services (NHS, police, fire/rescue and ambulance service), military staff, teachers and other school staff, social services staff, catering staff, and front-line council service staff.
