AS Level Results Summer 2020

You will already have received an email with your GCE AS Level results, along with any other Level 3 qualifications you have studied.

You will almost certainly have read a lot in the press about how grades have been derived this year after exams were cancelled due to the global pandemic. No doubt, there will be further press coverage on this over the next few days.

The grades you have received in the previous email are the official grades produced by the Awarding Body following a standardisation process on the grades submitted by the school (referred to as the Centre Assessed Grades or CAGs). For the sake of transparency, we are happy to share the Centre Assessed Grades which were generated after an exhaustive and thorough internal process that was quality assured at every stage. Where actual results differ from CAGs, this is as a result of the standardisation process conducted by Qualifications Wales which the school has played no part in. If you wish to have a copy of your Centre Assessed Grades, please email examsoffice@stcyres.org from your **school email address** and we will reply with the CAGs as soon as possible.

Please note that as we are very confident in the internal processes used to generate the Centre Assessed Grades, we will be using these CAGs to determine progression into Year 13. Therefore, it is our expectation that *all pupils* who wish to are able to continue into Year 13, regardless of the official Awarding Body grades. Please also note that these AS results will not form part the final A Level grade next year as final A Level grades at the end of next year will be solely determined by the examinations sat next summer.
