Dear Parent/Carer,

Following on from my letter sent earlier in April regarding minor changes to the school uniform, there were **no concerns** raised by parents by the deadline of the 19th April. We had three queries which have been answered separately and also below.

The Governing body will adopt the following changes for September:-

- We will move to a plain black 'A line' skirt (non pleated) of appropriate length (knee-length or below) and not tight fitting. Alternatively, black trousers of conventional width and style can also be worn. These can be purchased from supermarkets, as well as our school uniform providers.
- Black school shorts (*school trouser material*) can be worn, instead of the school logo school shorts. These can be purchased from any supermarket, as well as our school uniform providers. Sports shorts are not acceptable uniform.
- We will reduce our PE sports tops from three to two items.
- For PE lessons we will allow black plain sports leggings, black shorts or black tracksuit bottoms.

Please refer to the document 'School Equipment and Uniform Information 2024' for examples of acceptable schoolwear.

As mentioned in my previous email there will be a transitional period of at least a year. Therefore, if you have already purchased a pinstripe skirt for example then this is fine to wear for next academic year. I hope these changes support families and our community with reducing the cost of the school uniform.
