



In Cymraeg, you should ...

After each lesson

- Review your lesson notes and revise any new or difficult vocabulary and grammatical structures

Fortnightly

- Go through the Google Classroom and ensure that you have all the resources from the fortnight and have submitted any required work
- Check that you haven't missed anything and that you are confident in your understanding of the topics and vocabulary
- Speak to your teachers if you have missed anything or need any further guidance

Throughout the year

- Use revision materials available on Google Classroom, e.g. Blooket and Quizlet, to practise key terminology and patterns
- Immerse yourself in the Welsh language as much as possible, e.g. watching S4C Clic, reading articles on Golwg360, listening to Radio Cymru, following Welsh social media channels, attending local Welsh events; such as Tafwyl, theatre performances and Welsh gigs
