Building the Past Tense



Verb + Stem + Ending = Past Tense

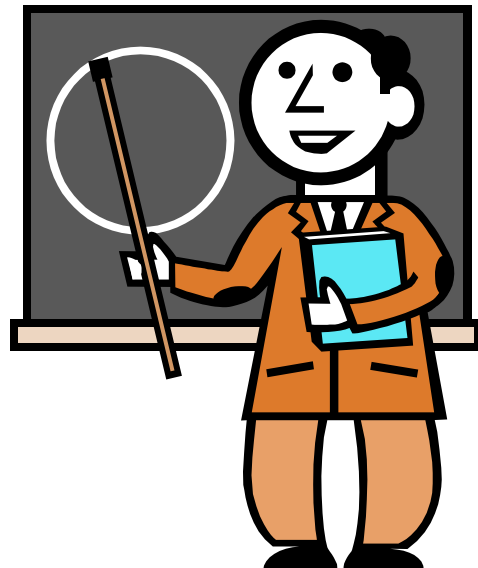
There are 3 steps to follow for regular verbs:

1. Pick your verb
2. Find the stem of this verb (*usually by removing -i, -o, -u, -a, -eg, -ed*)
3. Add the past tense ending to say who did the action
